They will discuss the process of designing and printing such fabrics, display beautiful quilts and other projects made with this exciting new fabric trend. The workshop is on using the Pineapple Rule (designed by Lynda and Nancy) to make pineapple quilts a snap. Learn to make perfect pineapples (log cabin variation) without using templates. This year our teams will come with their strips cut (accurately, of course).

From 42" width fabric (if fat quarters are used, cut double):

3 strips 3" wide Color A

3 strips 3" wide Color B

3 strips 5" wide Color C

3 strips 5" wide Color D

2 strips 5" wide Color Background

(I'd also suggest bringing the leftover fabric-you never know!)

You will be able to finish your pieced top if you also bring the following:

2 sewers (sewing machine, thread, etc.)

1 cutter (accurate, of course) (rotary cutting equipment)

1 presser/arranger (iron, ironing board-table top fine)

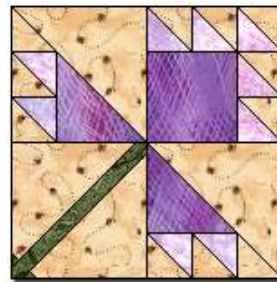
