Block of the Month: August

The block of the month for August is **Patchwork Strippy Quilt**. This block can be made in many different sizes. Please make yours a 12 inch "finished" block (12 1/2 inches square when you submit it.) The directions are available online and in your membership packet.

Per the notes in the membership packet, cut strips $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6" and then cut apart at $1\frac{1}{2}$ " intervals. Center strip should be $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ ".


