She will speak about "Folded Fabric Elegance" (three dimensional quilt art) on Tuesday night, and she will teach her workshop on "The Fifth Dimension" on Wednesday. The Fifth Dimension: Go beyond traditional 3-D. In this technique workshop you will learn 5 of the exotic and unusual methods that are the trademark of Rami's awardwinning works including hexagon and biscuit chopkey, mirror-imaged continuously folded prairie points, harlequin tucks, North American hand smoking and lined prairie points.

This workshop could be the answer to those who wish to know about adding 3dimensional textures and a lot more extra touches to art-to-wear and quilts.

In **February 2009**, our own historian, Linda Goforth, will give a presentation on the history of the Los Alamos Piecemakers. If you have any historical information or items of interest, please contact Linda.
