Trapunto is an Italian word meaning stuffed. Traditionally, this was accomplished by stuffing extra batting material into a piece after it was quilted.

This workshop will explore machine trapunto techniques to add a dimensional element to traditional quilts, wall-hangings or art quilts. With innovations such as wash-out thread machine trapunto is easy and creates dramatic effects.

Participants will make a basic trapunto setting block suitable for incorporation in a quilt and work on an appliqué, printed panel or make a larger trapunto piece suitable for a wall-hanging or pillow.

The \$40 class registration fee will go to the guild treasury to be used for future programs. You can sign up by calling or emailing Donna or me.

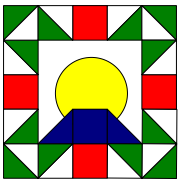
