The October meeting will be a sew-a-thon to assemble community service quilt tops. We will need, sewing machines with neutral colored thread, cutting mats, rotary cutters, rulers, irons and ironing boards. The Tuesday cluster has made up bundles of pre-cut fabric from the guild's stash for you to assemble. So there is no need to bring any fabric. I believe we have enough bundles to keep the sewers, cutters and irons busy for a couple of hours. However, feel free to bring fabric if you wish. The quilt pattern we will be assembling calls for 1 yd of a printed fabric sub cut into 14 - 2 1/2 inch strips, and 3 yards of a coordinating fabric sub-cut into 14 - 2 1/2 inch strips and 7 - 8 1/2 inch strips.





Perfect for professional quilters, this lecture is also great for the self-quilter with more projects than hours in a day. *Member Price:* \$25.00; *Non-members* \$30.00.

LECTURE/TRUNK SHOW & DINNER: Machine Quilting for the Modern Quilter: Friday, March 24, 2017 6:30pm-9pm Enjoy a fabulous evening with Angela, with a lecture and trunk show presentation featuring Angela's wonderful quilts. Angela gives an exciting talk about her process, and how to push your skills to the next level. She will share enough to get you all motivated, then send you home on a creative buzz! WORKSHOPS: Angela will teach three full days of hands-on classes, suitable for all skill levels from beginner to experienced quilter. Space is limited to 22 per day. Limited mid-arm and pre-loaded long-arm machines (provided by Handi Quilter) are available on a "first come" basis, or bring your own domestic machine. Each day's instruction stands alone, but there will be a progression to the material presented that we believe will provide a cumulative benefit to students who take all three days.

Learn designs that work in all differently shaped blocks as well as other areas of a quilt, including borders and negative space, and how to recognize the "dots" on your quilt and how you can adapt them for you.

Little Changes, Big Variety and Beyond Feathers 6 hours-9:00am-4:00pm-Friday, March 24, 2017. In this workshop you learn how small changes to classic machine quilting designs can create completely new designs. You will be amazed at how many designs you will learn and how many different ways you can use them. Do you love quilting feathers but are looking for something new? Angela will also show you some new motifs for your quilts. Get ready to try out scrolls, vines and circles in your quilt borders, sashing and blocks.

Quilting the Modern Quilt, and Negative Space, 6 hours-9:00am-4:00pm -Saturday, March 25, 2017. Angela will demystify all of the daunting aspects of quilting for the modern quilt, including how to handle solid and unconventional fabrics, irregular shapes, and a special focus on negative space. Angela will also include techniques for changing up the scale of your design, how to divide your piece into smaller spaces, and tips for adapting these methods to other parts of your quilt.
