From the President's Corner:

Dear Piecemakers,

I'm finally home from traveling. The Stickwork project in Portland/Hillsboro was AWESOME. So I only worked on the project in the mornings but had time to quilt in the evenings, put together 4 quilt tops and a denim blanket, which was given to an intern on the project.

So for our meeting next week, there will be a quilt-a-thon. The guild has been asked by "Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) if we would make a few quilts for foster children in our area. CASA provides volunteer advocacy for foster children in Santa Fe, Rio Arriba and Los Alamos and often these children have frequent moves and few personal items and we have found quilts are especially helpful for them at night, which can be an especially scary time for them." This is the reason we have quilt-a-thons, to make and give away quilts where it would help someone the best.

The quilt-a-thon next week will be a simple square pattern sewn in the usual way, then by making two strategic cuts and sewn back together, it is then on point. Erin Flesher, our co-vice president, will talk us through this process. There will be 6-1/2" squares from the guild stash (80) and borders, or you can bring your own and 6" squares will also work.

I will make an offer: if you finish your quilt top, make a backing, and get it to me before the June meeting, I will quilt it.

There will be some fabric pre-cut, but if you'd like to contribute, bring 6 1/2 - inch squares and/or 2 1/2 and 3 1/2 -inch strips for borders. Sewing machines, irons, ironing boards, rotary cutters, rulers, and mats will also be needed. Bring what you can, and do what you can. Hope to see you there.

NAME IT! I would like to resurrect the practice of having a contest to name the show. Members will vote on the winning name at the May mtg, and the winner will receive \$25. TAKE A SEAT! We need Show Chairs for the following positions:

- 1. **Silent Auction:** Charlene has volunteered to chair this position once more (THANKS!), and I can hardly wait to see what will be available.
- **2. Staffing:** this volunteer recruits/signs-up members to assist with various show jobs. It includes developing a schedule; recruiting volunteers at meetings or by phoning individuals to close any scheduling gaps.
- 3. Quilt Submission Chair: The responsibilities include managing/providing required forms/deadlines for show; tracking number of submissions by category/size; organize intake/return of submitted items, and prior to show provide Show Chair with expected number of items by category/size (this will help determine number of and space required for frames)

- 4. Door Prizes: This position includes soliciting/collecting door prizes to be given out the 2 days of the show, and organizing the issuance of the door prizes
- **5. Frame Chair:** This individual will arrange for the pick-up/return of the frames from the storage unit to the church and help organize assembly/set-up of the frames.
- **6. Vendor Chair:** I have already sent out the vendor contracts and we already have 2 vendors (!), but if someone would like to take over tracking the vendors/contracts and placement of vendor booths based on requirements that would be terrific!
- 7. **Last but not least** let's challenge ourselves and submit at least one item for the show! I know with your participation, talent and skill we will have another impressive show!

As we move forward we may require additional chairs at which time we will call for help. Also, I hope to provide Chairs with detailed instructions for the positions (I am trying to round up the blue folders with instructions, so if you happen to have from a previous show – let me know!)

Also, vendor information for LAP members will be available at upcoming mtgs. Remember LAP members pay a reduced fee of \$50 per space.
