Minutes from LAP Guild Meeting 6/27/17 at the United Church of Los Alamos:

The meeting was called to order.

Input from officers:

Vice President – Tonight's program is Albert Maggitti from Santa Fe. There won't be a meeting in July. The program in August will be the members of the Color Class at Atomic City Quilts. The September meeting will be the Pot Luck and will be on September 19th so we meet before the Quilt Show.

Secretary – No report.

Treasurer – Gross Receipts Tax has been filed.

Community Service – There is lots of fabric if anyone is looking for some for a community service project.

Membership – We have a returning member and a new member joining us tonight. There are currently 48 members. Brenda reminded us that a benefit of membership is that JoAnn's will give you a VIP card that gets 10% off.

Quilt Show – The Quilt Show will be September 22nd and 23rd and we don't have a name for the show yet. Chair persons are: Charlene—silent auction; Vendors—Linda (have 4 booths left); Staffing—Clara; We still need—Exhibit submission, Door prizes, and Community Service display.

Brenda also reminded us of the Jemez Bear Paws Quilt Show July 21 - 23.

Door Prizes – Winners: Lynn, Jo Ann, and Marion. A Gift Certificate to Atomic City Quilts was one of the door prizes.

Publicity – There has been an article about the guild in each local paper. Charlene has reserved the space for the banner for the quilt show.

Silent Auction for the Quilt Show – Zena will work with Charlene.

WEB – Lately there have been some issues with receiving the newsletter. Deb suggested to look on the web page if you don't get your newsletter.

It was announced that there is a quilt show in Montrose, CO. July 21 - 23. Nicole Dunn will do a featured lecture and classes.

Program – Sharon introduced Albert Maggitti.

He has been quilting since 1993 and restoring quilts for about 3 years. He talked about the emotional charge that quilts can have and told a story about a quilt brought into his shop that he couldn't fix.

A suggestion to matching fabric to replace some fabric that had been destroyed was to check in second hand stores. Or to design similar fabric on the computer and print it on to plain fabric. He suggested that an antique quilt should not be cleaned, not even spot cleaning. It can destroy the quilt.

Quilt restoration will usually take a lot of time, but it is usually the most gratifying solution. Conservation is no repairs but preserve the quilt. Cover worn spots with mesh and stitch it down

Albert defined vintage quilts as 20 - 25 years old and antique quilts as over 25 years old, but said that is not always consistent.

Show and Tell – Quilts were shown by Paula, Laura, Donna, Linda, Brenda and Micki. Albert then spent time answering questions and looking at the quilts brought in by guild members and giving suggestions for restoring/repairing our quilts.
