Minutes from LAP Guild Meeting 8/29/17 at the Presbyterian Church in White Rock: The meeting was called to order by Mickie.

Mickie talked about the woman who was hit by our quilt stand at the May Arts & Crafts Fair. We (the guild) covered \$254 of her uncovered medical costs.

At the August Arts & Crafts Fair the quilt was set up so it would not blow over as easily. We will be very careful when setting up the quilt from now on.

Mickie also read a couple of thank you notes from people at the chemo unit. They were very appreciative of the quilts that were given to them.

Input from officers:

Vice President – Sharon announced the September meeting would be the annual pot luck at the United Church on September 19^{th} from 6:00-8:00. She also announced the Team Competition would be discussed. Fabric will be handed out to each team. Teams must be at least two members (can be as large as you like). The quilt must be at least lap size and must represent all of the fabrics. The team will have until November to finish.
