Minutes from LAP Guild Meeting 2/27/18 at the United Church of Los Alamos:

The meeting began at 7:00 p.m. with Linda Kolar calling the meeting to order.

Linda passed out The Patchwork Puzzle sheet.

Officer Reports:

Vice President –There still no vice presidents.

Secretary – Joan will continue as secretary.

Treasurer – Books have been audited.

**Committee Reports:** 

Community Service – Flo thanked everyone who participated in the Valentine Lunch at the Senior Center. 25 people attended.

Library – Deb brought more books and CDs. She had the library list available.

Membership – Brenda introduced new members and gave them gift cards to the Los Alamos Quilt Shop.

Newsletter – Clara explained that if you are not getting the newsletter you should contact Deborah.

Webmaster - Nothing.

Donation Quilt – Michelle has volunteered to work with the donation quilt. Donna showed the quilt from the blocks that were made during the Saturday workshop. It is a beautiful modern quilt.

**New Business:** 

Linda is looking for ideas for programs. March will be a sew-a-thon for community service quilts. We will sew crazy nine patch blocks at the meeting. Linda will send out details. We will have a garage sale at the April meeting.

Jo Ann Painter told us about a UFO challenge she passed around a sign-up sheet. You can sign up for as many quilts as you like, but must pay \$1 for each UFO you sign up for. The quilt must

be quilted and bound to be considered complete. Your name will be put in the drawing for each completed quilt. There will be two names drawn for the prize (the amount collected in the kitty divided). If you give away the quilt before the drawing you will need to take a picture of the quilt.

There was some discussion about Quilt Market. We do not have volunteers. It was questioned if we should do it this year? It was decided to check with the church (we would have to schedule the church soon) and question if we would need to pay a cancellation fee if we end up skipping it this year.

There was also discussion about having a table at the Espanola Valley Fiber Arts Center Crawl in May. It was decided to make sure we can sell tickets for the donation quilt at our table. If it is ok, we will reserve the table for \$25.

Door prizes were drawn.

Show & Tell: Trish showed a quilt with Chinese fabric and rugs she has made. Mickie showed a quilt she had made with Crown Royal bags. Laura showed quilted bowl cozies she had made from layer cake 10" squares. Donna showed a wheel chair quilt (3' x 4') and a second quilt she had made from left over blocks from the donation quilt. She also showed a blue quilt she had made from a pattern from Shelley's. Charlene showed a bright, colorful quilt she made for a young girl she had met at chemo. Brenda showed a "quilt as you go" quilt she made and a t-shirt quilt she made for the injured junior firefighter from La Cueva. Roberta had made a quilt from older and reproduction fabrics that she was donating to Charlene. Melodie showed a tree wall hanging and a hand pieced grandmother's flower garden and embellished. Flo showed a pinwheel quilt donated to community service and a kitty tote bag she made.

Linda started the program which was Notions! Notions! Each showed their favorite notion and told why they were important. Ann had a ruler. Deb had tape to hold your ruler in place and a cleaner for your cutting mat. Joan had a porcupine quill to use as a stiletto. Jo Ann had a tiny thread pick (hook) to pull threads. Christy showed a head lamp and explained she used it for light when working on her quilts. Linda had several notions, including her Travelers Companion to find quilt shops along the road; her strip cutter and her pin tumbler (pintastic automatic pin dispenser). If you haven't seen one you need to google this tool.
