Liz talked about an exhibit the Historical Society is putting together at Fuller Lodge and there will be a quilt included. She asked for any input from members with ideas on how to put together the quilt.

Program:

Deb introduced Judith Roderick an art quilter and silk painter from Placitas. Judith is a SAQA member with quilts in the Out of the Blue show that was at the State Capital in Santa Fe most of the summer. She also had her Sand Hill Quilt in the "Life Along the Rio Grande" show, another SAQA show that was at the Mesa Library.

In 1975 she moved to Alamogordo and made batik clothing. She is now mostly doing silk painting. Silk painting starts with white silk which she paints with resists/wax and then steam sets them. She also paints silk to make scarfs. She showed her three silk painting/quilts that were in the "Out of the Blue" show. She uses different embellishments on her quilts including buttons and sea shells she was given by her mother.

After her talk we all got to look at the quilts up close and ask questions.

The meeting was adjourned.
