## **Vice Presidents (Brenda & Shelly):**

Our November LAP meeting will be Thursday, Nov 28 - NOTE TIME CHANGE - 6:00 pm for our annual Sew-A-Thon.

Please find a team of 2-3 people, one to sew, one to cut, one to press (pressing & cutting can be combined).

If you are the person to be cutting during the meeting, bring a small 6.5" square or a 6 x 12 ruler, along with mat and cutter.

If you would like to get a head start on your cutting, here are the instructions:

Take a 10" square fabric,

Cut off (2) 2.5" x 10" strips.

Subcut the remaining into (2) 5" squares.

You should end up with (4) pieces: (2) 2.5 x 10 & (2) 5 x 5

Repeat using a total of (32) 10" squares cut into 4 pieces.

The finished size will be perfect for a little one to donate to.

If you don't have a layer cake (10" square stacker) - we will have several at the meeting.

DON'T FORGET - Last FQ Exchange of the year - the theme is Christmas. Bring several to share!

The January meeting will be a demonstration meeting. Guild members will demo a variety of methods to make flying geese and continuous bias binding using the tube method.

If there is something you would like to see a demonstration of let Brenda or Shelly know.

At the February meeting we will learn about sublimation printing on fabric.
