Call to Order at 10:00 am United Church

Welcome to Carolyn visiting from the Embroiderers Guild in Los Alamos, also hello to Claire.

Officer reports

President -Linda is once again asking for a member to take over her position as President as she needs to monitor family members as they bid on silent auction items. Linda also has provided the plan for the April guild meeting. She printed out a pattern for members to make placemats. We will have a cutting party to make kits for members to make these placemats and return them at a future meeting. They will then be gifted to the Senior Centers. They will distribute them to those that receive home delivered meals. There are over 80 seniors in our community that receive delivered meals during the week.

Vice Presidents-Brenda / Shelly- Brenda announced the April plan to have a cutting party. She asked members to bring a cutting mat, rotary cutter and ruler. If we own fabric that would make a good placemat she asks that we bring it to share. There will also be a shed run to gather more fabric. The secretary asks, "Since this is a party, will there be cake?" This meeting will be held at the United Church in Los Alamos.

Brenda also extended an invitation to the guild members to join the Bear Paws group on April 13 for a sew-a-thon. The plan is to make cat carrier liners for a cat rescue group in the Jemez. They plan to meet at 10:00 AM at the Madonna Hall in Jemez Springs.

Sunshine Report-We sadly announce the passing of two great supporters of our guild. Keith Carr, husband of Flo Carr has passed away this month. Keith was better known as "the tall guy with the drill" and having patience in abundance. For many years he volunteered to put quilt racks together and take them down for our quilt shows and markets. His easy going and gentlemanly spirit will be missed.

Our other loss was Louise Taylor. She was an early and sustaining member of our guild. She held several positions on the board and helped guide and inspire many LAP members.

Program-Brenda introduced our speaker, Celeste Raffin. Besides being Brenda's sister-inlaw she is a Los Alamos native who has returned from Utah with her husband to retire in the Land of Enchantment.

She is an avid skier and mountain biker and a gifted and creative artist.

Her talk began with a lesson in physics. Her handout covered the information necessary for Dye Sublimation on anything that can withstand 400 degrees. She covered the topics of creating images using the computers and then producing the image on a specific "for dye sublimation" printer. Ink and paper must be specific for this purpose. The heat press to transfer the image to item must reach 400 degrees.

Celeste will be returning to her studio to begin creating again as soon as her home remodeling projects are accomplished.

Celeste was able to host LAP members at her home following the meeting to demonstrate the steps in dye sublimation and she showed other items she has made with this technique. Afterwards many LAP members remarked how much they enjoyed the program and studio visit. They look forward to seeing more of her work at shows and craft fairs.

Show and Tell-Roxanne brought a wonderful lap quilt that will be used as a raffle items for her dog club. Her second beauty was a pale orange "race strip" quilt.

Brenda brought her project from the workshop given by Nicole Dunn. It was a small wall quilt composed of a pine tree in winter using Nicole's technique of manipulating fabric to look like drifted snow and adding snippets of fabric to arrange flakes on tree limbs and on the ground. Brenda added sparkles to the snowfall by adding beads.

Donna showed her workshop piece which was a snow scene with trees in the background as well as the fore ground. Her satin fabric was manipulated to create large snowdrifts and the grey blue sky gave an authentic picture of a mountain snowscape.

Announcements- Micki announced she will be picking up donations this month to take to the Dine quilters near Gallup. She is hoping to gather more machines and fabric before she packs up the car to meet the women in Gallup.

Next meeting will be Tuesday, April 23 at the United Church in Los Alamos. We will be 'Cutting it Up'' Bring cutting mats, rotary cutters and some fabric.
