## Officer Reports

President- Linda states she has collected 46 placemats. She completed 23 from kits made at the April meeting. The goal is to make 80 for the Senior Center for the home delivered meals. Please finish and return placemats at the next few meetings so they can be presented in September.

Vice Presidents- Brenda announced that Ann Siewart will be presenting the guild program and workshop in June. Ann and her husband Michael own Thread Bear Quilt Store in Las Cruces. Ann is a certified Deb Tucker instructor. She will present a trunk show and give us info regarding the use of Deb Tucker rulers. Michael will be bringing a pop-up store to sell fabric and notions. He will set up on Tuesday before the meeting and all day on Wednesday.

In the workshop on Wednesday July 26 we will be constructing blocks using the LeMoyne Star ruler. There is a pattern that comes with the ruler for the block that we will be making. The class fee is \$55.00 for members and \$65.00 for non-members. We meet from 9-3.

The July workshop with Holly of Sew Together Quilt Shop has been cancelled. Brenda hopes to reschedule in 2025.

In August the Jemez Bear Paws will present a trunk show of a BOM they have been working on. This meeting will be held in White Rock.

In September, Liz Martineau will present "Fabric Journal Making" or sometimes called "Junk Journals". She asks if anybody has a fabric journal to bring it to the September meeting.

Kay also mentioned that SAQA will be showing an exhibit at the Step-Up Gallery at the Mesa Public Library from September 20 until October 20. They are showing "Personality Plus" and the "Telephone Game".

# Committee reports

Every piece has information regarding the artist and the inspiration that motivated the making of the art piece. Show and Tell- Donna started us out with a "find" she wanted to share. She is most impressed with her new pins called Magic Pins.

Abbey completes another of her kits bought during the 2023 quilt show from the Busy Bee Quilt Shop. This one was the "Wild and Free" panel. She quilted it by stitching the river systems in the USA as her quilting motif.

Melodie brought a giraffe quilt called Raffe. It was a paper piece quilt made from a kit from Legit Kits.

Susan brought another paper pieced quilt from Legit Kits. It was a gigantic motorcycle that she estimated took 350 hours to complete.

Clara showed a birthday quilt for her granddaughter. She used a panel of cats and dogs and added patchwork to finish the blocks. She has also finished her snow scene wallhanging from Nicole's class. She really liked how it came together and might make another one of a different season.

Brenda brought a gift she received of a cardboard horse head that was decoupaged with fabric with a yarn mane embellishment with beads.
